- Welcome clients to the foodbank centre and check their referral status on our database (training provided)
- Talk through their food package requirements and prepare their food parcels according to the standard packing lists
- Make refreshments and tidy up as required during the session
- Offer a listening ear to clients, with the goal of understanding the root causes of their need for Foodbank. This is achieved by having good knowledge of our internal referral projects and external signposting options. Training and guidance will be provided
- Work under the guidance of the session supervisor
- Deliver your role with consideration of the health & safety, confidentiality and safeguarding concerns for your team and service users. Any concerns to be reported to your session supervisor or the staff contact for your session
